Established in 1990, the South Palm Beach County Women's Tennis Association is the most popular and prestigious league in South Florida. Levels range from advanced beginners to former top ranked professionals playing weekly in a structured match format. Matches consist of both home and away games and the season runs from early fall to late spring. Participation in this league provides a wonderful opportunity to play competitive tennis and represent your community. Lotus is thrilled to be a part of the SPBCWTA. We currently offer 3 teams' practices per week for Divisions 1A, 2B & 7.

**Pickleball Clinic 101:** This program is designed for players that have no prior experience and are looking to play this amazing sport! Coaches will teach players everything they need to know from basic skills, court positioning, technique, strategy, and scoring. Registration for each session is required 24 hours before the class start time. You must book your reservation on our website and pay in advance to participate. Cost \$30

**Dink Master League:** Thisis the first Pickleball League in Palm Beach County with no age restrictions and a unique format. Created by our Director of Racquets and other local Directors of distinguished communities in the area, the goal of Dink Master is to provide fun competitive pickleball for residents

while representing their respective communities. Residents of Lotus are having a great time while developing new friendships, improving their game, and playing quality matches in the neighborhood and surrounding clubs. We currently offer this program for a variety of levels including Division 1, 2 and a women's only division.

The Lotus Junior Program: Designed as an 8-week program to ensure commitment, quality, and improvement. To register you must select at least 1 day per week for the entire 8-week session when you complete your booking. It needs to be the same day(s) each week over the course of the 8-week program. Upon conclusion of the first session, if you have had rain outs that you were unable to reschedule or a notified illness, classes can be carried over to the next session. Rain days will be announced 1 hour prior to the class start time, and a credit will be issued in case of weather conditions. If you are rained out of your class, you will have the option to select another class day for that week. Custom price packages available based on attendance.

**Tennis Future Stars (ages 4–6):** This program is created to introduce tennis to your 4–6-year-old with our fun and exciting approach! In our Future Stars class, your up-and-coming tennis players will develop hand-eye coordination along with motor skills through tennis inspired games. Junior low pressure red dot



tennis balls are used to maximize a successful experience for your junior.

**Tennis Junior Challengers ages 6-12**: Designed to build upon the fundamentals in a fun and educational way for children ages 6-12. Children will learn and improve on basic tennis skills in a fun, caring, and safe environment adapted to their needs. A modified tennis court, low pressure balls, among other training tools help to create an overall positive experience for your junior.

**Tennis Top Guns (ages 12-16):** This program is geared to all teenagers, from beginners to advanced players who are new to competitive match play. We require the student to know just the basic strokes and we will further develop and focus on the following: serving, competition, matches, rules, and fun team building exercises.

**Pickleball Round Robin:** This tournament style event allows men and women to sign up as individuals and the professional will set up teams. The format includes match play to 11 points rotating partners each round. Players should be familiar with the scoring system and level appropriate for match play. Registration for each session is required 24 hours before the class start time. You must book your reservation on our website and pay in advance to participate. Cost \$10.



**Men's King Division Palm Tennis:** The goal of Palm Tennis Men's King Division is to provide a competitive night league for the men of South Florida. Each season runs 14 weeks in length and matches are played on Thursday evenings. The King Division is for men rated 4.5 (advanced) or higher. Typically, 10-14 teams from other clubs compete and awards are given for the top 2 teams. Competitive match play and sportsmanship have proven successful for the Lotus Men's King team.


